



SURREY RIFLE ASSOCIATION – SCATT TERMS & CONDITIONS

This document outlines the terms & conditions associated with the usage of the club’s SCATT electronic training equipment. The equipment is for the benefit of all shooting members of the SRA and therefore each member has a duty of care regarding its use. Each member using the equipment (not only those signing equipment in/out) should sign a copy of this document.

Terms & Conditions of usage of SCATT electronic training equipment:

- Equipment is to be signed-for by the member(s) responsible for its use and the SRA Committee member issuing it
- Equipment is to be physically checked out/in against the asset listing below
- SCATT is to be used within the confines of the SRA clubhouse and NOT taken outdoors or off the SRA premises
- SCATT is to be used according to the SRA operating instructions issued with the equipment
- Member(s) accept responsibility for any damage caused to the equipment as a result of negligence or any usage not in compliance with the operating instructions (this includes the replacement cost of relevant component parts of the SCATT system)
- The equipment is to be used by SRA members, only
- Members must report any damage/fault/defect to/of the equipment to an SRA Committee member as soon as possible
- Equipment is to be signed-in after use, to certify that all equipment has been returned and is in good working order

The most delicate part of the SCATT system is the optical sensor which is susceptible to being knocked / bumped or jarred. This is likely to damage the optical sensor and will be treated as negligence on the part of the user.
